Criticism AutoCAD is the most popular 2D drafting program in use by CAD operators worldwide

and the second most popular general-purpose CAD package, behind only Inventor in the CAD

industry. According to IHS analyst R. J. Goering, by 2004, AutoCAD had an 83% share of the market; Inventor had a 14% share. By 2010, Inventor's share had increased to about 27%, while

AutoCAD's share decreased to about 60%. AutoCAD has been the subject of several usability

studies. Howard Rheingold and Frank C. Crow elaborated a model for creating usable systems; in

their model, usability is based on the user's expectations of how a system should behave. This

approach to usability led them to suggest that AutoCAD violated expectations regarding four of six criteria: time, error, frustration, and effort. The study drew criticism from CAD vendors and users.

Some argued that the study oversimplified the issues involved, especially in a complex system like CAD; the presentation of the study's findings was described as "convoluted" and "dry." In 2003, the

product received a 1.5 star rating in the PC Magazine usability score of all major CAD programs. The score was the lowest in the usability category. The magazine's writer, Linda Hasdorff, also found the interface to be confusing. In 2010, CAD Review rated AutoCAD 2018 "moderately successful" in the following categories: precision, accuracy, display, data integrity and performance. The results of this study were based on an analysis of 13,000 drawings and less than 1000 parameter changes. Since version 14, AutoCAD has not provided a truly 3D view that provides true stereoscopic depth for users that work with a computer using a head-mounted display, as is possible using some other CAD packages. As part of an effort to improve the user interface and new methods of plotting, the company introduced AutoCAD 360 3D in 2016. Other criticism has been related to its use of proprietary technology and an emphasis on the completeness of its feature set, as opposed to ease of use and compatibility with other software packages. In 2006, AutoCAD was one of the top five CAD software programs with the highest cost, requiring licenses of more than \$250,000 for firms in the U.S. In 2008, IHS Cautela predicted that, by 2013, Inventor would become the most used CAD a1d647c40b

Version 2023 is the first AutoCAD release to incorporate the new "Markup" feature. The new feature enables you to incorporate comments into your drawings using any of the modern printing technologies such as a PDF or a printout. You can annotate your drawings with notes, stamps, sketches, arrows, or other graphic symbols. Later, you can merge or compare your notes against the original, or review and edit them before sending them back to a client. You can create static drawings from your comments or a database or simply send them to your partners. You can also import or synchronize comments from another project. The imported comments are stored in a database and can be linked to a drawing, a project, or to external users such as customers. A drawing can be associated with several project log files. In addition, you can add a comment to a previously imported drawing or to a new drawing and associate the drawing with a project. Feedback comments can be marked and starred for later synchronization. For example, you can add a comment to a set of drawings, assign a tag to that comment, and synchronize the comments between all the drawings. New operations for exporting comments are available in version 2023, such as exporting comments to a color printer or exporting comments to a PDF file. You can also associate a comment with an external comment import, so that users can import comments that you have

created in a previous project. For example, you can import a couple of lines to complete the functionality of a previous drawing, or import a comment to add comments to a drawing that you are currently working on. The new "Quick Info" feature enables you to access all comment information for all objects in a drawing. In addition, new settings have been added for the new "Markup" feature. For example, the Drawing Defaults dialog box is now named Markup Options. In addition, the Markup export options have been renamed to Export Options.
