HISTORICAL ICONS

Rajwada Palace



Built in the year 1766 by the rulers of the Holkar Dynasty, Rajwada Palace is seven-storied building exhibiting a mix of Maratha, French, and Mughal architectural styles.

Krishna Pura Chhatra



These structures house the remains of the deceased members of the Holkar Dynasty. Built in the 19th century over the place where these rulers were cremated comprises of three chhatris.

Chhatra of Malhar Rao Holkar



Erected by Maharani Ahilya Bai Holkar in 1766 A.D, Chhatra of Malhar Rao Holkar was built to honor the great Maratha general. It stands apart with its beautiful carvings and magnificent architecture.

HISTORICAL ICONS

Gandhi Hall



Built in 1904 Gandhi Hall is the most prominent historical building in the city. The building features the Indo-Gothic style of architecture. The building was initially named King Edward Hall and was renamed as Gandhi Hall after India's independence.

Lal Bagh Palace



Construction of Lal Bagh Palace began in the late nineteenth century and was completed in 1926 by the Holkar dynasty. It was served as the residence of the Holkar rulers. The architecture reflects Italian Renaissance Revival style, making it one of India's finest neo-classical buildings.

BLESSED PILGRIMAGE

Khajrana Ganesh Temple



Dedicated to Lord Ganesh, Khajrana Ganesh Temple is the famous and most visited pilgrimage center of Indore. Temple was constructed by Rani Ahilyabai Holkar. The special day for temple is Wednesday.

Annapurna Temple



This temple was built in 1959 by Rani Ahilyabai Holkar. The temple is dedicated to Goddess Annapurna, the goddess of food. The architectural grandeur is reminiscent of the famous Meenakshi Temple

Kanch Mandir



This is a wonderful, exquisite work of art and a seat of Jain faith. Temple has statue of Lord Mahavir. It houses walls, ceilings, floor, doors, windows all made of glass and the roof remains adorned by glass cut chandeliers.

BLESSED PILGRIMAGE

Bada Ganpati Temple



In the heart of the city, this temple was built in 1875 by Sri Dadhich. The temple has Asia's largest Statue of Lord Ganesh measuring 25 feet from foot to crown.

Bijasan Tekri



It is the temple dedicated to Bijasan Mata, who is considered to be an incarnation of Goddess Durga. The temple stands on top of an 800-foot hill, which is known as Tekri.

Ranjeet Hanuman



Ranjeet Hanuman is the only Hanuman temple in the world where Hanuman ji is standing with shield and sword in his hand and Ahiravana is at his feet. This temple was established 125 years ago.

BLESSED PILGRIMAGE

Gopal Mandir



Established in the respect of Lord Krishna, the sanctuary is worked by Krishna Bai Holkar in 1832. Gopal Mandir is a marble-winding structure worked in Maratha style of design.

Pitra Parvat



Built by 125 artisans in Gwalior, the 66 feet high idol of Hanuman is installed on Pitra Parvat. Idol was built in 264 parts in 7 years. It took about two years to connect these parts. The weight of the idol is said to be 108 tonnes, the length of the mace is 45 feet.

JYOTIRLING DARSHAN

Mahakaleshwar Ujjain



Shri Mahakaleshwar of Ujjain is known among the twelve celebrated Jyotirlingas in India. The glory of Mahakaleshwar temple has been vividly described in various Purans. Starting with Kalidasa, many sanskrit poets have eulogized this temple in emotive terms.

Omkareshwar



Omkareshwar Jyotirlinga a shiv temple on Omkar Mountain an island in mid Narmada, revered Hindu temple is the center of extreme faith. There are 12 jyotirlinga temples in India and omkareshwar is one of them.

MUSEUM

Indore Central Museum



It is located near the General Post Office in Indore. There are two galleries in the Museum. The artefacts exhibited in the museum range from the prehistoric to the modern era.

Infantry Museum Mhow



The Infantry Research Centre and Museum is India's 1st and only Infantry Museum. It showcases the evolution of the modern Indian Infantry from 1747 onwards.

NEAR BY GETAWAY

Jam Gate



Jam Gate is a historical monument located near Indore on the Khargone - Indore state highway. It majestically stands out in a mountainous backdrop giving a view of the deep valleys below. It was the gateway of the historic plateaus of Malwa and the plains of Nimar.

Patalpani



The Patalpani Waterfall is located in the Mhow Tehsil of Indore district and is a popular picnic spot for the locals of the area. Surrounded by dense forest covers and majestic hills Patalpani plummets from a height of 300 metres.

Choral



Choral Dam is a hidden gem 40km from Indore that will definitely provide you with quietness and tranquillity. Constructed around the backwaters of River Narmada, Choral Dam is replete with cool and clear water.

NEAR BY GETAWAY

Tincha Fall



Tincha Fall is located near village Tincha and is approximately 25 km away from Indore. The Tincha Fall is an ideal place to spend some leisure time escaping the city chaos.

Lotus Valley



The prime attraction of Gulawat Lotus Valley Indore is a lake that is fully-fledged with thousands of beautiful lotuses on its surface, which makes it Asia's Largest Lotus Valley. The place is also known by the name of Lotus Lake.

Janapav



Located on the Mumbai-Indore Highway, Janpav Kuti is situated in the hills of the Malwa plateau. It is a mountain at an altitude of 881 meters above sea level surrounded by dense forest. The place is valued by Hindus and holds mythological significance as it is believed to be the birthplace of Lord Parashurama.

HERITAGE STAY

Maheshwar



90km from Indore Situated on the banks of river Narmada, Maheshwar appeals to both the pilgrim as well as the tourist in you. If you happen to drive through the main road of Maheshwar, which also serves as a state highway, you may come across several mesmerizing sights of the holy River Narmada, its rich history, and the reflection of the Maratha and Malwa empires that ruled over years.

Mandav



90km drive from Indore Mandu is an ancient fort city in the central Indian state of Madhya Pradesh. It's surrounded by stone walls dotted with darwazas (gateways). It's also known for its Afghan architectural heritage. Landmark buildings include Hoshang Shah's Tomb, a domed marble mausoleum, and the vast Jama Masjid mosque, with courtyards framed by colonnades.

WILDLIFE TRIP

Indore Zoo



Kamla Nehru Zoological Museum or Indore Zoo is a zoological park located in Navlakha, Indore, wholly owned by the Indore Municipal Corporation. It is one of the largest zoological parks and one of the oldest zoological parks in the state of Madhya Pradesh.

Ralamandal Wildlife Sanctuary



Ralamandal Wildlife Sanctuary is one of the most popular wildlife reserves in India. Established in 1989, this sanctuary spread over 234.550 hac. is an abode to some flora and fauna, indigenous to this part of the country.

WATERSIDE TRIPS

Yeshwant Sagar



Yashwant Sagar is a dam reservoir on Gambhir river, located around 26 kilometers west of Indore near Hatod village on Indore-Depalpur Road. On August 13, 2022, 11 water bodies in five states were given Ramsar site status by the Union Ministry of Forest, Environment and Climate Change, including Yashwant Sagar in Indore district of Madhya Pradesh.

Sirpur Lake



Sirpur Lake is located on Indore-Dhar Road in Indore. The total area of the lake and its surrounding protected region is 800 acres and falls under the jurisdiction of the Indore Municipal Corporation. The wetland has been designated as a Ramsar site under the Ramsar Convention on 07-01-2022.

FOOD DESTINATIONS

Chappan Dukan



The famous food street Chappan Dukan is a heaven for people who love to eat or love to have a snack. Chappan Dukan is like a food treasure trunk with assorted dishes including North Indian, South Indian dishes. From thelas of pani puris to a bowl of Noodles you get every bit of taste along the lane of Chappan.

Sarafa Night Food Market
